

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy refers to the cookies used by the www.atellaniapartments.com website to provide, improve, promote and protect User's browsing within the site.

Cookies are small portions of text transmitted to your device once you find yourself browsing the site. These have different functions as they can allow, for example, to store some information directly provided by the user and concerning navigation within the site.

The Website uses the following cookies:

- Browsing cookies: these are all cookies that allow the Site to function properly and allow those who visit it to view the contents of the Site. In the event that you decide to disable the aforementioned type of cookies, you may experience a malfunction of the Website. These cookies are not stored permanently on the User's computer and disappear when the browser is closed;
- Google Analytics Cookies: Website uses cookies related to Google Analytics service of Google, Inc., in order to process statistical analysis on how users navigate the Site. The IP addresses of the users are anonymized before being saved by the Google Analytics service;
- Technical cookies necessary to keep track of the consent given by the User.
- Third-party cookies: set by a domain different from the one visited by the user. If a user visits a site and a different company sends the information using that site, it is in the presence of third-party cookies.

Furthermore, the Website uses cookies on social platforms (in this case, on Twitter, Instagram and LinkedIn platforms), managed by the third parties involved. These cookies are necessary to allow these social accounts to interact with the site, allow them to express their appreciation and share it with their friends. Cookies on social platforms are not necessary for browsing.

The cookies & privacy policies of the main social networks connected to our site may be subject to changes of which our company is not responsible. The User is therefore invited to periodically review the aforementioned sections in order to monitor any changes in relation to the cookie and the privacy policy made by the individual social networks.

How to change the settings on cookies. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but the user can normally disable this function by manually changing the setting. You can block or limit all types of cookies, accepting to receive only some and disabling others. The "Options" or "Preferences" section in the browser menu used allows you to avoid receiving cookies and other user tracking technologies, obtaining a notification from the browser of the activation of these technologies. The user can consult the "Help" section in the toolbar in all the main browsers.
